#### **JOB OPENING: FACILITY AND GROUNDS MAINTENANCE SPECIALIST**

**GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:** The Facility and Grounds Maintenance Specialist of Toyota Park is responsible to the head of Stadium Operations. The Facility and Grounds Maintenance Specialist is responsible for the maintenance and improvements of the Stadium Game Field, practice fields (2) and all landscaped grounds surrounding the stadium. The person in this position will ensure that all areas are kept in top condition for full and productive use.

#### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

- Maintain athletic fields and grounds in top condition to ensure full and productive use.
- Ability to nights and weekends to accommodate Stadium schedule.
- Appropriately operate all equipment, machinery as necessary and including Terraplas installations.
- Oversee maintenance of practice fields and stadium greenery.

#### **EXAMPLE OF DUTIES:**

- Perform duties related to ground care activities.
- Perform all tasks related to the preparation of the athletic field for games, practices, and events.
- Perform the preparation and herbicides and insecticides to grounds in compliance with all federal, state, and local regulations.
- Provide and maintain a plan for long-range maintenance needs of the athletic field.
- Maintain and operate all irrigation systems.
- Remove snow and ice as necessary.
- Maintain a high standard of safety, cleanliness, and efficiency in all grounds keeping projects.
- Performs off season maintenance regarding building and unrelated athletic events, plus other work as assigned.
