PERSONNEL BOARD MINUTES
July 29, 2019
7:00PM
MAYOR'S CONFERENCE AREA

Chairman Lewis called the July 29, 2019 Meeting of the Personnel Board to order at 7:00pm.

Roll Call indicated that Members Regep, Gholeh, Mazarka, and Chairman Lewis were present. There was a quorum.

Also present were Attorney Katherine Ellis and Secretary to the Personnel Board, Cathy Siciliano.

Chairman Lewis looked for a motion to approve the Minutes for meeting of June 24, 2019.

Motion was made by Member Regep and seconded by Member Gholeh. Roll call vote:

AYES: Members Regep, Gholeh, Mazarka and Chairman Lewis.

NAYS: None.

There being four ayes and no nays, the MOTION CARRIED.

The Board's attorney discussed Rule VI of the Promotional Examinations for the Bridgeview Police Department with the members of the Personnel Board. Attorney Ellis stated that there is a split between the two sections within the promotional examinations. The main goal is to amend the Police section. Board Member Mazarka asked if there was a provision for military merits. The Chairman replied that there was not in this agreement with the Police.

Chairman Lewis asked for a motion to approve the revisions to be adopted by the Personnel Board's Rules and Regulations as presented by our counsel. Motion was made by Member Gholeh and seconded by Member Mazarka. Roll call vote:

AYES: Members Regep, Gholeh, Mazarka and Chairman Lewis.

NAYS: None.

There being four ayes and no nays, the MOTION CARRIED.

Chairman Lewis looked for a motion to approve Stanard & Associates to handle the Police promotional written exam and its assessment center for the next sergeant test. Motion was made by Member Gholeh and seconded by member Mazarka. Roll call vote:

AYES: Members Regep, Gholeh, Mazarka and Chairman Lewis.

NAYS: None.

There being four ayes and no nays, the MOTION CARRIED.

Chairman Lewis looked for a motion to approve November 23, 2019 as the date for the sergeants' written exam. Motion was made by Member Mazarka and seconded by Member Gholeh. Roll call vote:

AYES: Members Regep, Gholeh, Mazarka and Chairman Lewis.

NAYS: None.

There being four ayes and no nays, the MOTION CARRIED.

Chairman Lewis stated that the chairman, the attorney and the secretary to the Personnel Board will have access to the keys for the Personnel Board's files.

Chairman Lewis looked for a motion to go into closed session for matters of personnel, closed session minutes, polygraphs, psychological results and background checks and auxiliary police officer candidates' applications. Motion was made by Member Regep and seconded by Member Gholeh. Roll call vote:

AYES: Members Regep, Gholeh, Mazarka and Chairman Lewis.

NAYS: None.

There being four ayes and no nays, the MOTION CARRIED.

The Personnel Board went into closed session at 7:19pm

The Personnel Board returned to open session at 7:59pm.

Chairman Lewis looked for a motion to approve the following individuals be sent for further processing by Human Resources—Andres Alvarez, Irene Ferrara Rojano and Jasmeet Sanghera as entry level firefighters. Motion was made by Member Regep and seconded by Member Gholeh. Prior to the vote, Chairman Lewis stated that these individuals have taken and passed the polygraph, psychological and basic background. Roll call vote:

AYES: Members Regep, Gholeh, Mazarka and Chairman Lewis.

NAYS: None.

There being four ayes and no nays, the MOTION CARRIED.

Chairman Lewis looked for a motion to send Jesse Daniel ahead in the entry level firefighter process pending written results of his written psychological background. Motion was made by Member Mazarka and seconded by Member Regep. Roll call vote:

AYES: Members Regep, Gholeh, Mazarka and Chairman Lewis.

NAYS: None.

There being four ayes and no nays, the MOTION CARRIED.

Chairman Lewis stated that for the record, he passed the polygraph and the basic background.

Chairman Lewis looked for a motion to send the following individuals as auxiliary candidates to Stanard & Associates for psychological background testing—Bernardo Aviles and Johnny

Crowder. Motion was made by Member Gholeh and seconded by Member Regep. Roll call vote:

AYES: Members Regep, Goleh, Mazarka and Chairman Lewis.

NAYS: None.

There being four ayes and no nays, the MOTION CARRIED.

Chairman Lewis looked for a motion to approve the closed session minutes from June 24, 2019.

Motion was made by Member Regep and seconded by Member Mazarka. Roll call vote:

AYES: Members Regep, Gholeh, Mazarka and Chairman Lewis.

NAYS: None.

There being four ayes and no nays, the MOTION CARRIED.

Chairman Lewis looked for a motion to send the three newest auxiliary candidates to the Police Department for fingerprints and a background checks and interviews for the following meeting.

Motion was made by Member Gholeh and seconded by Member Regep. Roll call vote:

AYES: Members Regep, Gholeh, Mazarka and Chairman Lewis.

NAYS: None.

There being four ayes and no nays, the MOTION CARRIED.

Chairman Lewis looked for a motion to adjourn. Motion was made by Member Gholeh and seconded by Member Mazarka. By voice vote, the MOTION CARRIED.

The meeting adjourned at 8:03pm.
